<b>Arrival &amp; Checking In</b>		
1	<input type="checkbox"/>	Park RV near entrance or office as indicated by signs, doing your best not to block other traffic
<b>Check in</b>		
1	<input type="checkbox"/>	Ask if discount is offered for RV club members such as the Good Sam Club, or Escapees (generally 10% to 15% discount on daily rates)
2	<input type="checkbox"/>	Request a map of the park and directions on best way to drive to your slot
3	<input type="checkbox"/>	Request directions to park facilities of interest, including entry codes, if any
4	<input type="checkbox"/>	Ask if Internet access is offered and details on how to use it (WiFi SID and password, data phone line location, etc. See Internet Access)
5	<input type="checkbox"/>	If arriving after office is closed, look for after-hours check in instructions posted near entrance or office
<b>Locating RV Slot</b>		
1	<input type="checkbox"/>	Find your slot on park map and determine entry and exit paths
2	<input type="checkbox"/>	Walk or take alternate transportation to RV slot before driving RV into park (Strongly recommended for large RV's to avoid potential tight spots. See article Hard Labor Creek State Park Earned Its Name.)
3	<input type="checkbox"/>	Before driving RV into park, determine if park roads can safely accommodate RV entry and exit (keep an eye on narrow roads, sharp corners, low trees, etc.)
4	<input type="checkbox"/>	Before driving RV into park, determine if RV will fit into slot and if all slides can be deployed (keep an eye on trees, fences, utility poles, picnic tables, etc.)
5	<input type="checkbox"/>	Confirm that slot has expected facilities (electricity with correct amperage and plugs, water, sewer, etc.)
6	<input type="checkbox"/>	Test water faucet, especially in freezing weather
7	<input type="checkbox"/>	Plan RV approach path and angle, especially if this is a back in slot
8	<input type="checkbox"/>	Driving In & Parking
9	<input type="checkbox"/>	If slot has no sewer facilities, drive to dump station and empty waste tanks, if needed
10	<input type="checkbox"/>	If slot has no water, drive to water source and fill fresh water tanks, if needed
11	<input type="checkbox"/>	Perform a two-way radio check, if using a spotter
12	<input type="checkbox"/>	Drive RV into slot and position as desired (be considerate to your neighbors by not crowding too close to their space)
13	<input type="checkbox"/>	Confirm that all necessary facilities are reachable from this position (electric, water, sewer, cable TV, etc.)
14	<input type="checkbox"/>	Walk around RV to confirm position allows deployment of slides and other RV features without obstruction (consider slide positions as deployed, awnings, steps, decks, etc.)
15	<input type="checkbox"/>	Check for high obstructions such as tree limbs (even small limbs almost touching RV can cause noise and damage slide covers in wind)
16	<input type="checkbox"/>	If clearance cannot be accurately determined, temporarily deploy slides and other features to confirm clearance
17	<input type="checkbox"/>	If slides or other features were temporarily deployed to check clearance, move slides, etc. back in until RV is completely parked and level
18	<input type="checkbox"/>	Determine if RV is level laterally (place level on floor inside RV or use level attached to outside of RV)
19	<input type="checkbox"/>	Chock trailer wheels
20	<input type="checkbox"/>	Place blocks under leveling jacks or tongue jack (to prevent sinking and marking paved surface)

21	<input type="checkbox"/>	Lower leveling or tongue jacks until they support front weight of trailer
22	<input type="checkbox"/>	Remove safety chains (TT only)
23	<input type="checkbox"/>	Remove sway bars (TT only)
24	<input type="checkbox"/>	Disconnect RV umbilical cord from the tow vehicle
25	<input type="checkbox"/>	Disconnect RV breakaway switch cable from the tow vehicle
26	<input type="checkbox"/>	Unhitch RV from tow vehicle
<b>Setting Up</b>		
27	<input type="checkbox"/>	Turn on propane water heater, if needed
28	<input type="checkbox"/>	Turn on water pump, if no external water source is available
29	<input type="checkbox"/>	Confirm that refrigerator is turned on and running on AC
30	<input type="checkbox"/>	Turn on air conditioners or furnace and set thermostat
31	<input type="checkbox"/>	Remove items from RV which are kept outside (chairs, grills, etc.)
32	<input type="checkbox"/>	Remove all fasteners used to secure cabinet doors and other items
33	<input type="checkbox"/>	Unlock tabs on external range hood vent
34	<input type="checkbox"/>	Return all items to their normal locations
35	<input type="checkbox"/>	Raise roof-mounted TV antenna

14	<input type="checkbox"/>	Check tow vehicle fluid levels (oil, transmission, brake, coolant, power steering)
15	<input type="checkbox"/>	Inspect hitch to make sure it is attached securely to tow vehicle (nuts, bolts, welding, etc.)
16	<input type="checkbox"/>	Close gray tank valves to collect water for flushing sewer hose after dumping black tank
17	<input type="checkbox"/>	Fill fresh water tank to desired level (keep in mind water weight)

2	<input type="checkbox"/>	Check RV tire pressure
3	<input type="checkbox"/>	Check RV wheel lug nut torque
4	<input type="checkbox"/>	Fuel up the tow vehicle

Departure		
1	<input type="checkbox"/>	Lower roof-mounted TV antenna
2	<input type="checkbox"/>	Collect and store all items from outside the RV (chairs, mats, satellite dishes on tripods, grills, etc.)
3	<input type="checkbox"/>	Secure items inside cabinets and storage compartments
4	<input type="checkbox"/>	Secure items on kitchen sink and counter
5	<input type="checkbox"/>	Secure items on bathroom sink
6	<input type="checkbox"/>	Secure items in shower
7	<input type="checkbox"/>	Lay down and pad large items which may fall or shift (chairs, tables, cabinets, etc.)
8	<input type="checkbox"/>	Turn off air conditioning units
9	<input type="checkbox"/>	Confirm that all sliding trays are latched and secure (external storage compartment trays, propane bottle trays, battery trays)
10	<input type="checkbox"/>	Empty black tanks (do this first so sewer hose gets flushed with contents of gray tanks)
11	<input type="checkbox"/>	Close black tank valves
12	<input type="checkbox"/>	Empty gray tanks
13	<input type="checkbox"/>	Close gray tank valves
14	<input type="checkbox"/>	Add treatment chemicals and a small amount of water to black tanks
15	<input type="checkbox"/>	If traveling with pets, make arrangements for their needs (put food, water, bed, leash, etc. into tow vehicle)
16	<input type="checkbox"/>	Disconnect electricity, and store cable and adapters
17	<input type="checkbox"/>	Disconnect sewer hose, and store hose and relating accessories
18	<input type="checkbox"/>	Disconnect water hose, and store hose and relating accessories
19	<input type="checkbox"/>	Turn off all RV lights (to prevent unnecessary battery drain)
20	<input type="checkbox"/>	Turn off water pump
21	<input type="checkbox"/>	Confirm that refrigerator is running on 12 volt DC or is turned off
22	<input type="checkbox"/>	Turn off all other propane appliances (water heater, furnace)
23	<input type="checkbox"/>	Shut off all propane bottle valves
24	<input type="checkbox"/>	Discard all trash
25	<input type="checkbox"/>	Stowe all remaining external RV features such as hand rails, steps, decks, etc.
26	<input type="checkbox"/>	Raise or remove all stabilizer jacks (leave front leveling jacks or tongue jacks down)
27	<input type="checkbox"/>	Close front storage compartment door
28	<input type="checkbox"/>	Hitch RV to tow vehicle
29	<input type="checkbox"/>	Connect RV breakaway switch cable to the tow vehicle
30	<input type="checkbox"/>	Connect RV umbilical cord to the tow vehicle
31	<input type="checkbox"/>	Attach sway bars (TT only)
32	<input type="checkbox"/>	Attach safety chains (TT only)
33	<input type="checkbox"/>	Raise leveling or tongue jacks
34	<input type="checkbox"/>	Collect and store leveling blocks from under jacks
35	<input type="checkbox"/>	Remove wheel chocks
36	<input type="checkbox"/>	Confirm that all is clear under the RV (all jacks are raised or removed)
37	<input type="checkbox"/>	Confirm that all slides are moved in completely and check overall exterior of RV for protruding items.
38	<input type="checkbox"/>	If RV wheels are resting on leveling blocks, move RV off blocks, collect and store blocks
39	<input type="checkbox"/>	Close all internal doors (bathroom, bedroom, living room)
40	<input type="checkbox"/>	Lock all external RV doors and panels
41	<input type="checkbox"/>	Check RV and tow vehicle lights (including signal and break lights)

42	<input type="checkbox"/>	Check RV brakes (three methods: press tow vehicle brake pedal, engage RV brakes only by using trailer brake controller inside tow vehicle, pull breakaway switch cable on RV)
43	<input type="checkbox"/>	Double check that trailer is hitched securely to tow vehicle. Confirm that all safety devices have been correctly applied.
44	<input type="checkbox"/>	Perform a final walk around. Look under and around RV. Confirm all jacks are up and nothing is protruding from sides or roof.
45	<input type="checkbox"/>	Check tow vehicle mirrors, and adjust if necessary (Attach mirrors)
46	<input type="checkbox"/>	Record tow vehicle's starting miles:
47	<input type="checkbox"/>	If you are not certain how much your RV weighs, drive to a truck scale and confirm that all weights are within tow vehicle and trailer ratings (see Understanding RV Weights and Truck Ratings for RV Towing)
48	<input type="checkbox"/>	Awning secured
49	<input type="checkbox"/>	Buckle safety restraints inside the TT.
50	<input type="checkbox"/>	Clean up after pets
51	<input type="checkbox"/>	Empty and stow trashcans/pickup trash

5	<input type="checkbox"/>	Water pump does <u>not</u> turn on occasionally when all faucets are closed <u>and</u> ice maker is turned off (if yes, then there may be a leak)

7	<input type="checkbox"/>	Fresh water tank level indicator

2	<input type="checkbox"/>	Black tank level indicator
