TIPS, TRICKS, AND RULES FOR OUR TRAILER GUESTS

- **No shoes** are allowed in trailer. Please bring pair of sandals or flip flops to use when coming in and out frequently.
- Our **hot water** is REALLY hot. Use caution.
- Remember that the **restroom has no lock on it**. Please be respectful and knock before barging in.
- When going #2 in toilet, **consider filling bowl partially with water** first (by pressing half-way down on the foot pedal).
- Do not put food waste or grease down the sink drain.
- Nothing is allowed in toilet except the provided toilet paper, water, and human waste. Do <u>NOT</u> put wet wipes or feminine products in the toilet. Those items can be put in the garbage can in the bathroom.
- **Have a trailer key with you** when leaving the trailer, especially at night. Sometimes the lock latch is engaged and you don't want to get locked out.
- Do not leave the awning out when away from the trailer. A strong wind gusts will tear it right off.
- Do not allow small children to play with the trailer control buttons, slide outs, etc.
- Close roof vents if the air condition is on or if it is raining.
- When camping without hookups...
 - please use water sparingly and conserve! The fresh water tank only holds 52 gallons. Bottled drinking water is provided. Consider using paper/plastic products instead of washing dishes. Shower quickly and only use the water you need. Don't leave faucets or fixtures running unnecessarily.
 - please use electricity sparingly. Use what you need, but only what you need. Don't leave unnecessary lights on.
