

Convert WeberQ 1000, 1200, 100 or 120 for RV connect and still have throw away bottle option. Cost is \$26.93:

Watts LFA-706 Brass Female Pipe Coupler (1/8" FIP to 1/8" FIP) \$2.93



Steps:

- 1) Remove regulator by unscrewing the regulator from the Weber Q. You should end up with an exposed 1/8" MNPT (a male threaded piece poking out from behind the Weber's control knob).
- 2) Screw/attach the Watts LFA-706 to the Weber 1/8 MNPT that's sticking out.
- 3) Screw attach the Model 250 1/8" MNPT end of the Male Plug to the other end of the LFA-706
- 4) Your RV's propane hose should now just attach to the Male Plug.
- 5) Screw/insert the Model 250 1/8" MNPT end of the Quick Connect into the regulator you just removed from the Weber Q. If you want to make your Weber portable again, just push the Quick Connect end onto that new Male Plug you just installed.

Final note. Suggest using pipe tape on all these connects. Be sure to check for leaks.

you have a Q dedicated to travel, replace the reg with a male plug and get an extension.

 Model 250 Quick Connect X 1/8" MNPT \$18.00	After removing the WeberQ regulator, screw/insert this 1/8" MNPT end into the regulator where you unscrewed the regulator off of the WeberQ . If you ever want to use throw aways again, just attach this Model 250 Quick Connect end onto the Model 250 Male Plug below that is to be mounted on the WeberQ when regulator is removed.
 Model 250 Male Plug X 1/8" MNPT \$6.00	Also need from Lowe's a Watts LFA-706 Female Pipe Coupling, 1/8-Inch FIP (both ends are 1/8" FIP. Screw/attach 1 end of LFA706 to where you unscrewed the WeberQ regulator. Screw/attach 1/8" MNPT end of Model 250 to other end. Male Plug end will now accept either an RV direct connect or the adapter above.
